These attacks, known as complex coordinated attacks, involve multiple threats that overwhelm conventional response tactics.

- Enhance response capabilities and command strategies of participants
- Increase networking, joint response capabilities of members of various disciplines and jurisdictions

**Target Audience:** Emergency responders: police, fire, EMS, those likely to assume command during response to a complex coordinated attack.
